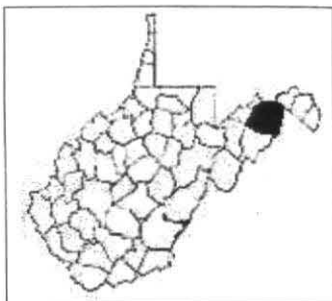

Describe Setting	
This house is located in central Hampshire County, in a rural area northeast of the unincorporated village of Augusta.

Description of Buildings or Site (Original and Present)	
2 Stories 3 Front Bays	
2-story I-house of wood construction, altered considerably less than most in this area, incorporating a 3-bay façade shielded by a small hip-roof porch which itself is supported by turned wood posts and ornamented with the original sawn brackets, 2/2, with modestly molded window heads. Rearward-projecting ell with a side porch. A centered pediment is on the gable, and the eaves are trimmed with dentil bands. The gable on the façade and the pediments on the gable ends are finished in diagonally placed vertical siding. A 2-story bay window is on the side elevation, along with a double-gallery porch.

In close proximity on the opposite side of the road are a series of agricultural dependencies including medium size sheds and a large bank barn, all of wood construction and all finished in vertical siding.

Statement of Significance:	
This farmhouse is considerably less altered than most in this area, retaining its original exterior finish, fenestration, etc. It appears eligible for the National Register under Criterion C for architecture, as a well-preserved Hampshire County I-house. This preliminary evaluation would have to be confirmed with an inspection of the interior and the concurrence of the SHPO.
