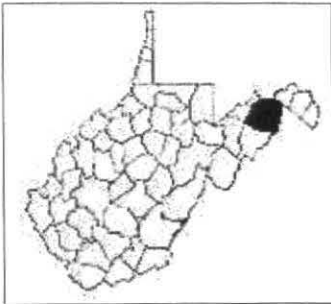

Side-gable roof with an exterior gable-end furnace chimney of concrete block construction. Fenestration is flat-topped, with one 6/6 window retained. Paired entry doors on the façade. The building is vacant and appears deteriorated.
