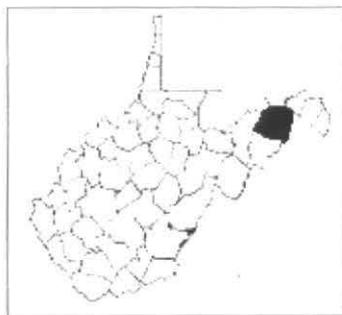

Fenestration incorporates 6/6 windows along with 4-light eyebrow windows above a hipped-roof screened-in porch on the façade. Gable-roofed ell at the rear.
