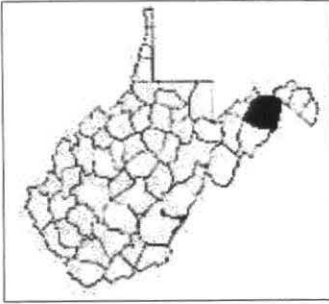

2-story residence of wood construction with an L-shaped footprint and intersecting gable roof with a centered brick chimney on the façade. Extending across the façade and a portion of the side elevation is a wrap-around veranda supported by non-historic wood posts and enclosed within a non-historic wood balustrade; the veranda rests on a foundation of smooth-dressed concrete block. Fenestration is flat-topped, 6/6 replacement sash. Paired entry doors are on the façade. The exterior surfaces are partially clad in asbestos shingles, some of which is missing and reveals the original weatherboard finishes.
