2-story I-house of wood construction with a side-gable roof and a shed-roof addition on the rear. The façade of the first story is three bays in width, the second story is of two bays, a design feature seen elsewhere throughout this area. Extending across the façade is a hipped-roof porch clad in standing-seem metal, supported by plain wood posts. Fenestration is flat-topped, 6/6. The exterior is clad in asphalt shingles, as is the foundation.
