2-story I-house of wood construction, with a side-gable roof and interior gable-end red brick chimneys. The exterior surfaces are clad in non-historic siding, and a 2-story bay window is on the easternmost bay of the façade. Extending across the innermost bays of the façade is an Eastlake-style porch retaining its original turned posts, sawn brackets, and upper balustrade. Fenestration is flat-topped, 2/2, without notable ornament. An enclosed back porch is on the rear elevation.
