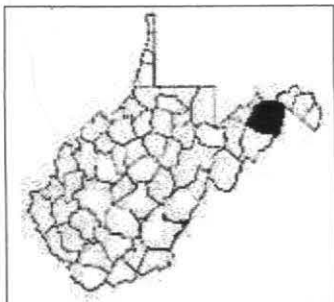

Single door on rollers in centered on the west elevation and a louvered gable-roofed cupola is centered on the ridgeline of the roof.
