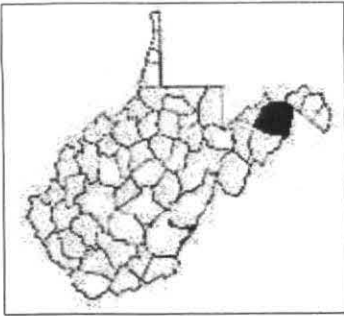

Statement of Significance:	
This appears to be an early log house, the type of which is not often seen in this area. These were among the first domestic architecture erected during Hampshire County's settlement period and, assuming it has not been moved and reassembled, it may be eligible for the National Register under Criterion C for architecture, although this preliminary evaluation would have to be confirmed by an examination of the interior and would require the concurrence of the SHPO.
