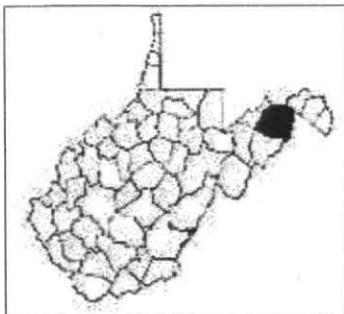

This is an unusually large ruin of what appears to have been an industrial building built of structural tile. Foundation evidence suggests that at least one addition has been removed. The interior of the building is open to the elements and its steel framing is evident.

Statement of Significance:

This is a substantial former commercial/industrial building which does not meet National Register Criteria for Evaluation because of its deteriorated condition. It is, however, among the largest buildings in this area. Neals Run was originally known as Cacapehon until April 15, 1925, when the local post office's name changed to Neals Run. Cacapehon is an antiquated spelling of "Cacapon" and the community was named so for its proximity to the Little Cacapon River.
