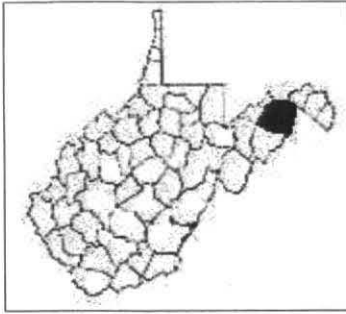

This house is located along a rural road west of the South Branch of the Potomac River, in rural central Hampshire County north of the county seat of Romney, south of the unincorporated village of Green Spring.

1½ Stories 3 Front Bays	
1½-story stylized Cape Cod-style residence of wood construction, with a side-gable roof and paired gable dormers on the façade, with partial returns of the cornice on the gable ends. Symmetrical 3-bay façade with a centered entrance, flanked by paired windows. Shed-roof porch with replacement wrought-iron supported and a replacement wrought-iron balustrade. Fenestration is flat-top, set singly and in pairs, without notable ornament.
