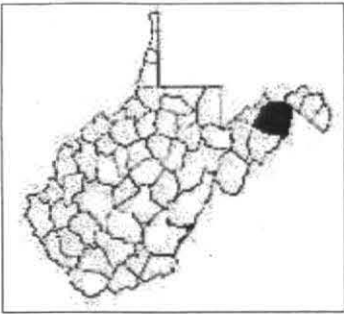

2-story American Foursquare of wood construction with an asymmetrical 3-bay façade with the main entrance offset, shielded by a pedimented portico which is supported by wrought-iron posts and enclosed within a wrought-iron balustrade. Fenestration is flat-top, incorporating multi-light sash along with a 3-unit window on the façade. The slope of the roof is penetrated by a red brick furnace chimney and what appears to have been a back porch has been enclosed.
