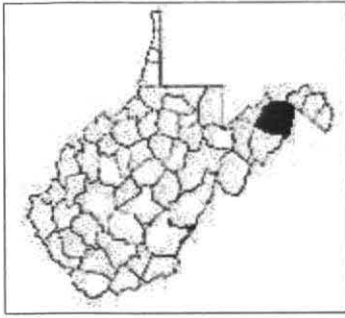

2-story vernacular residence of wood construction, with a side-gable roof penetrated on the ridgeline by a red brick furnace chimney. Exterior concrete block chimney is on the north gable end. The façade is dominated by a substantial gabled wall dormer. Portions of the front porch appear to have been enclosed. Fenestration is flat-top, without notable ornament.
