Statement of Significance It is the opinion of the surveyor that this ca. 1920 vernacular-style dwelling lacks sufficient architectural and historical significance and is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register. It does not possess characteristics of demonstrable significance with respect to design, construction or use of materials (Criterion C) and has been altered with replacement cladding, windows, and porch rail and steps. As such, its architectural integrity has been compromised. It does not appear to be associated with significant broad patterns, events or persons (Criteria A and B). 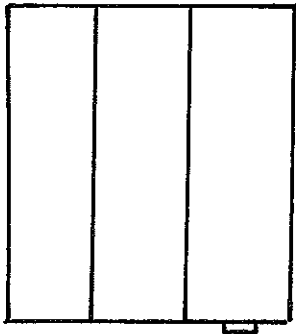
