Describe Setting The grassy property, southeast of Dillons Run Road, is backed by mature woods. Grade rises gently from the road. _____ Acres _____ Archaeological Artifacts Present					
Description of Building or Site (Original and Present) _____ 1 _____ Stories _____ 3 _____ Front Bays The principal resource is a one-story gable-front church, three bays deep. A stone foundation supports wood-lap siding-clad walls. The roofing is painted standing-seam metal. Three pairs of two-panel wood shutters block the side windows, but the front (southwest) door has a transom. Deep eaves have wood plank fascia and running trim, and seven machine-cut cornice-profile wood brackets per side. The front eave returns have two wood brackets each. Steps to the door are missing. (Use Continuation Sheets)					
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Describe All Outbuildings The secondary resource is a graveyard south of the church, fenced with chain-link. The headstones date back to 1900. (Use Continuation Sheets)					
Statement of Significance It is the opinion of the surveyor that this Italianate-style church, constructed ca. 1870 is eligible for inclusion in the National Register under Criterion C for its architectural significance as a rare surviving example of a late nineteenth century Italianate-style church in Hampshire County. The building retains sufficient architectural integrity to convey its significance with respect to design, construction, and use of materials. As a religious building, the church is not eligible under Criteria A and B (significant broad patterns, events or persons) but Criteria Consideration A governing Religious Properties can be applied, as it derives its primary significance from its architectural distinction. It has not yielded, nor is it likely to yield, information important to history or prehistory (Criterion D). (Use Continuation Sheets)

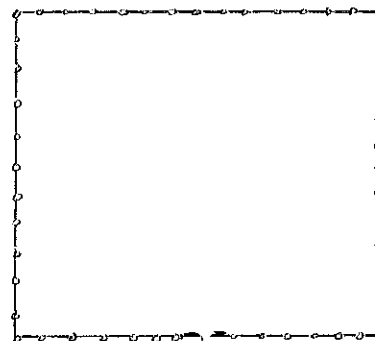
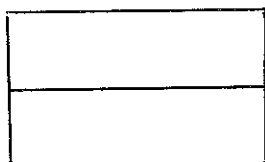
