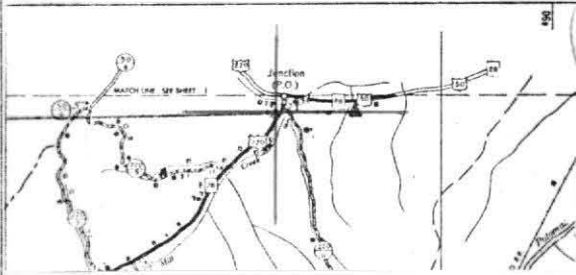

Corbel-capped brick chimneys are at each end, one on the exterior and one on the interior. Windows are 2/2. Perhaps the most interesting feature is the small porch that is at the central entrance. The bracketing atop its turned posts is intricate and detailed.

	STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE	Based on the physical structure: the building appears to be a good, representative late 19th century farmhouse of the area. Corbel-capped chimneys and a well-designed porch complement the overall detailing.
