Description of Building or Site (Original and Present) 2 1/2 Stories <u> 6 </u> Front Bays Two houses joined. The older one is constructed of limestone with massive gable end chimneys. Hipped roof, screened in second floor gallery supported by bold wood posts, 6/1 double hung sash on rear. Façade faces away from street, with 6/6 double hung replacement sash, working shutters, bold stone lintels. Four bays with left side entry. Newer house is a Federal I House, circa 1790. Gable end chimneys, brick construction three bay, center hall 1/1 double hung newer sash. Greek revival portico supported by double square columns and single pilasters joined by a plain railing and spindles. Very slight pediment, bold cornice.
