Description of Building or Site (Original and Present) 2 Stories 2 Front Bays Gable front building with two paneled entries with three-light transoms over, and heavy stone lintels. Two widows above have 6/1 double hung sash with stone sills and lintels and functional shutters. The gable peak has a stylized small Palladian window, also with heavy stone sill and lintel. The flush right side extension was constructed in 1959 and features one bay, an entry. Six/1 sash above. Covered basement entry on the right face of the addition. The steeple is square with metal tiles and fancy brackets to support the four sided rising spire. Louvered vents on all faces of the base.
