Description of Building or Site (Original and Present) 2 1/2 Stories 4 Front Bays This is a much altered stage coach house constructed of logs. The original section, facing Rt. 28 is a three bay side hall log cabin with a bold stone chimney on the right gable end. There is a one story stone veneer extension on the right face and a large rear extension with a hipped porch roof supported by turned and milled porch posts and curved brackets All windows are 6/6 or 4/4 double hung replacement sash. The back porch is partially enclosed. There is a narrow sheltered gallery extending the length of the rear extension. Bold lintels above the façade and left face windows. Broken pedimented lintel above side hall.
