covered. According to inspection files, unknown repairs were done in 1972, 1978, 1982, and 1985. Field observation noted diaphragms at bottom chord and diagonals were strengthened and railing missing in some places. Pin connected bridge is closed

to vehicular traffic and bypassed by steel girder bridge (west).
