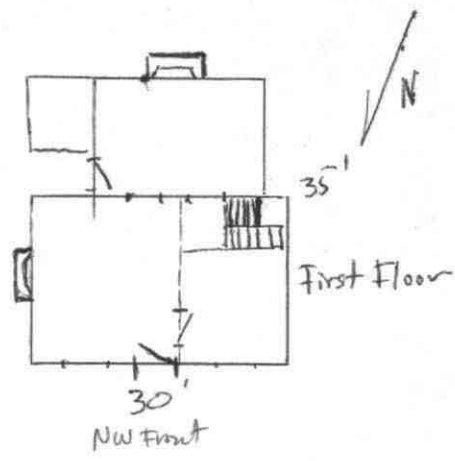

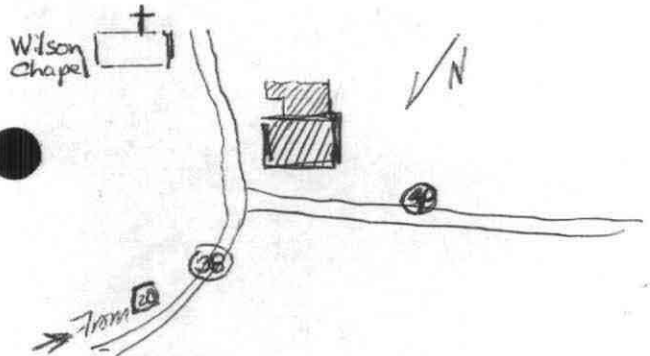


First Floor
