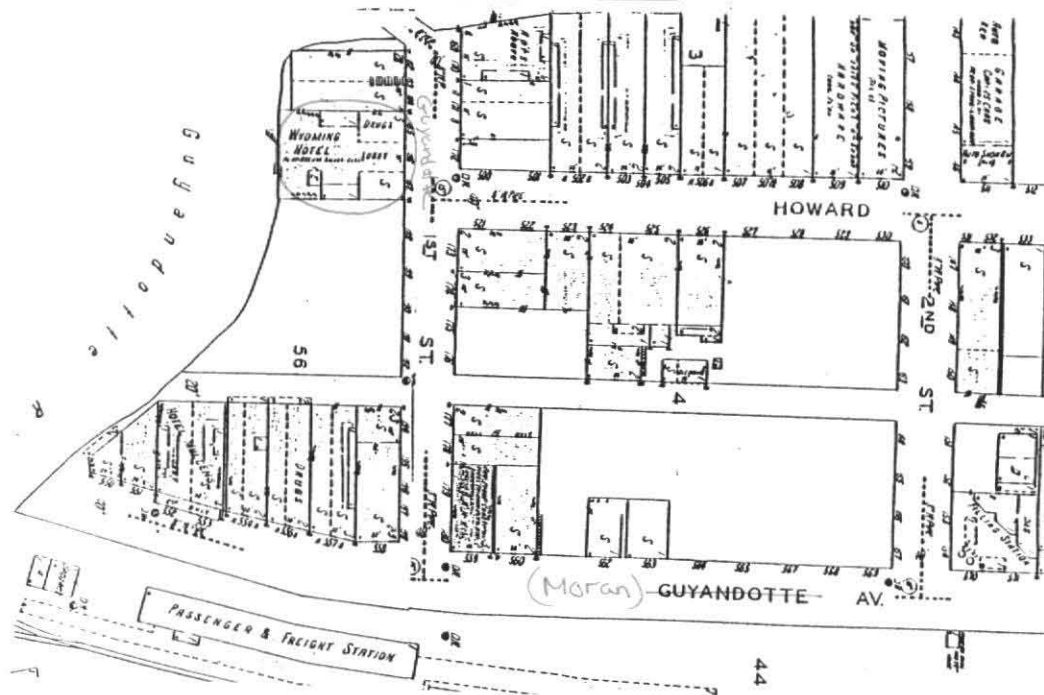

HISTORICAL/CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE

The first commercial coal mine in the county was located in Mullens in 1908. In 1906, the Virginian Railroad reached the town, and in 1912 the town was incorporated. The downtown commercial district encompasses architectural materials and styles spanning over 90 years; from Jenny Lind structures to structures built of native stone, to ornate brick warehouses and grand hotels and banks.
