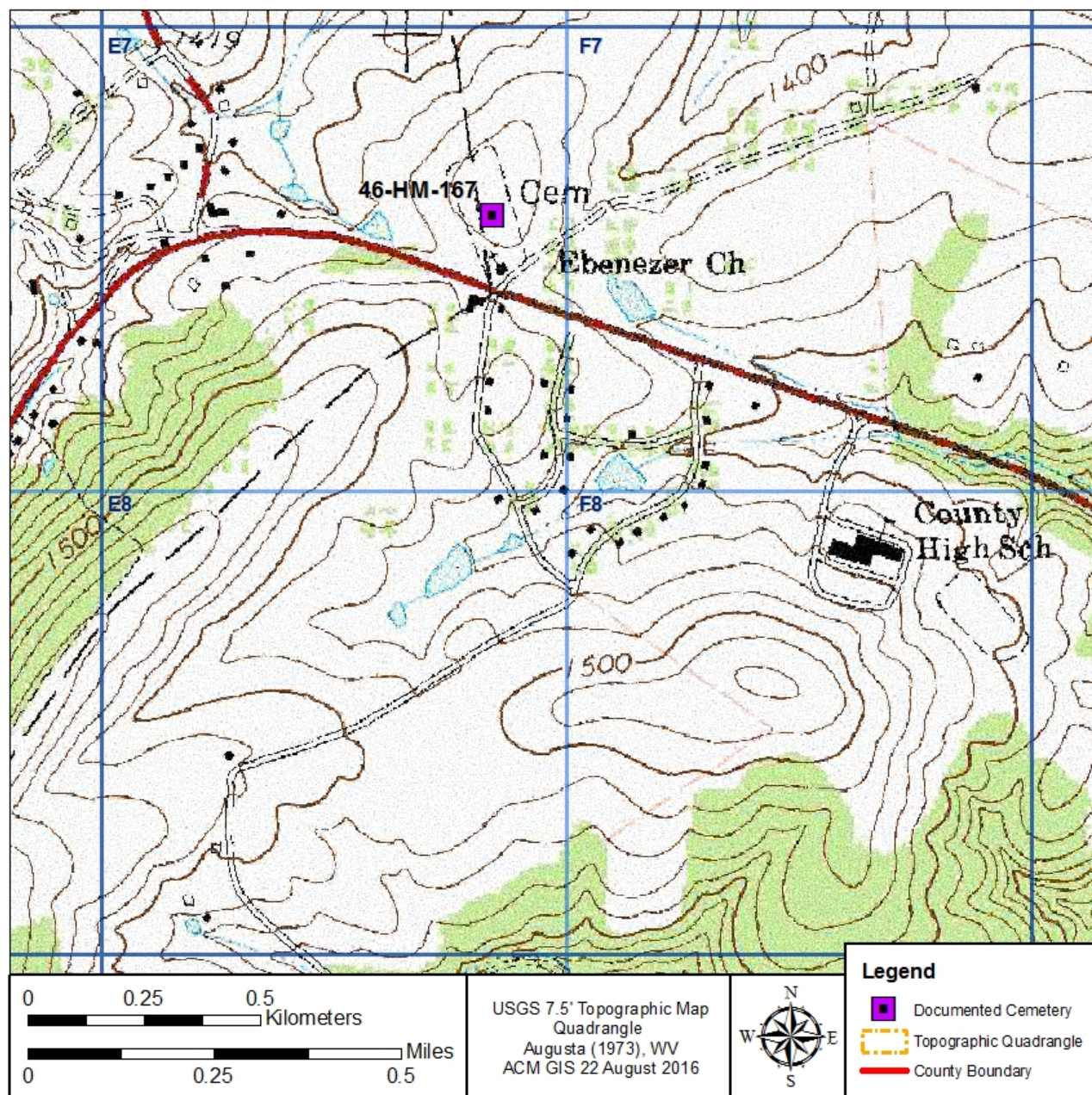

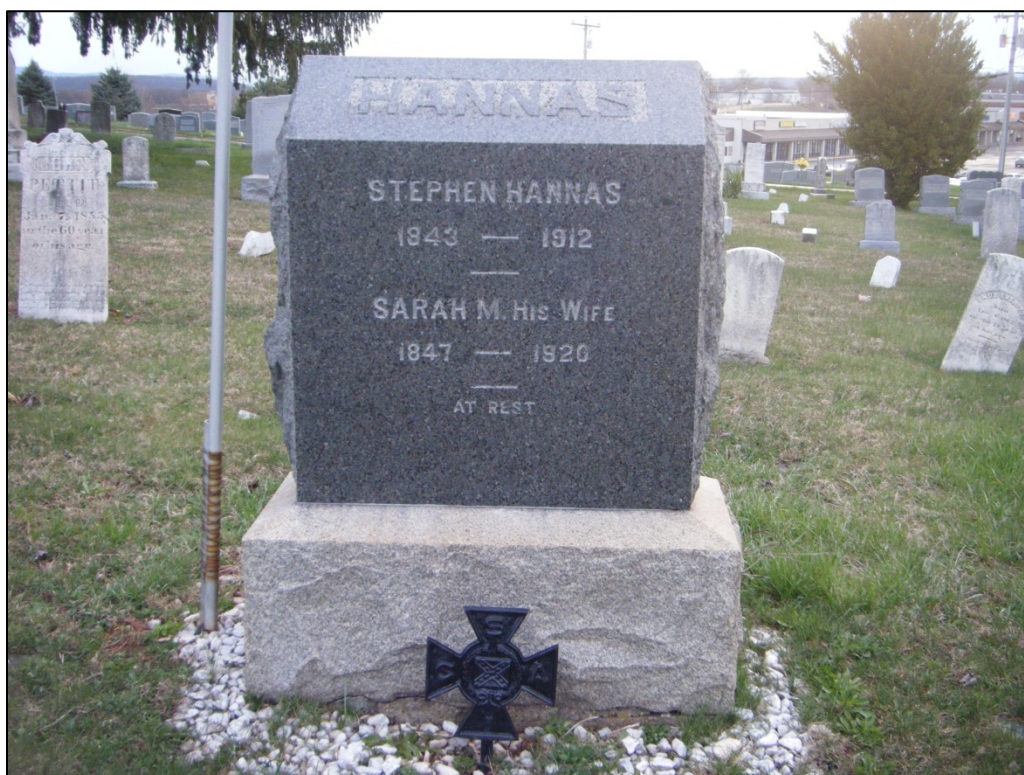
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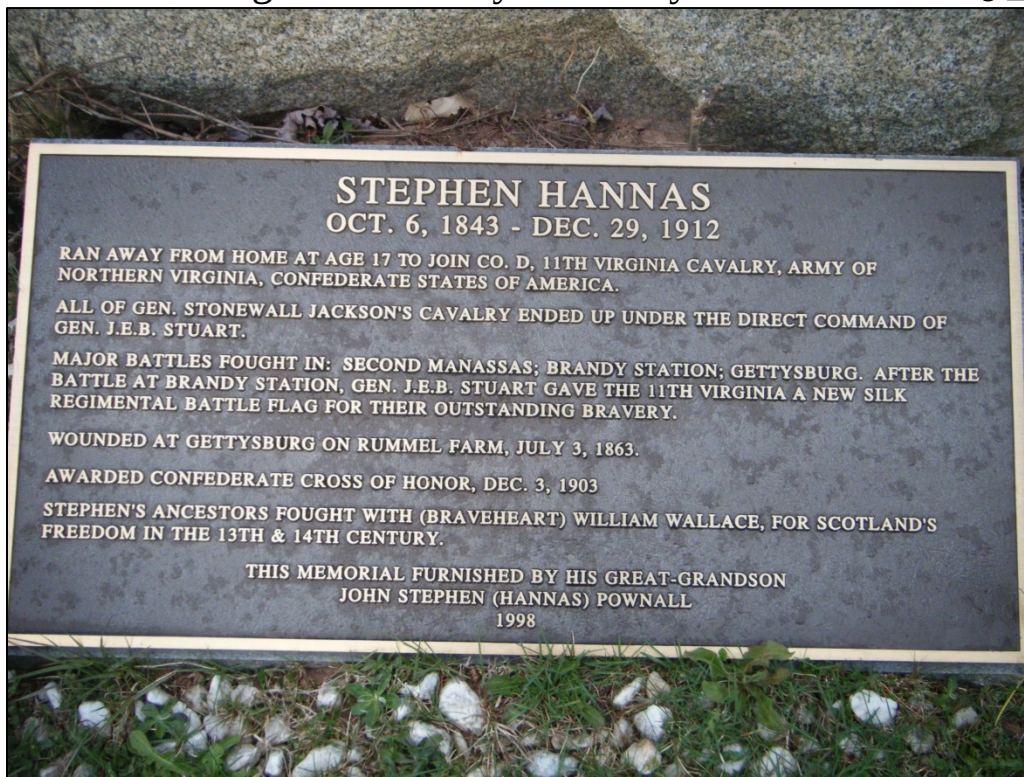




Photograph of 46-HM-167, looking north.
